




WHAT MAKES AN ENERGY EFFICIENT HOME?

Energy efficient homes are often rated by the Home Energy Rating System (HERS) Index which is an industry standard that measures the energy efficiency of a home. The HERS Index is a nationally recognized system and performance indicator for inspecting and calculating a home's energy savings.

A certified HERS rater can determine a home's HERS Index and compares it against a 'reference home' of the same size and shape. For example, a home with a HERS Index of 65 is 35% more efficient than the HERS reference home. The lower the HERS Index, the more energy efficient the home and the more you can expect to save on your utility bills.



Homes can also be ENERGY STAR® certified by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the U.S. Department of Energy. Homes with a lower HERS Index and/or with an ENERGY STAR certification are more energy efficient than a standard home.
